## TransitChek

A well-seasoned favorite, TransitChek is the region's original transit voucher program that allows employees to purchase their fares for less. Employers can either serve the program as a company-paid benefit (a tax-deductible business expense), or allow employees to partake through pre-tax payroll deductions (saving on taxes for both the employee and the employer).

TransitCheks are accepted by SEPTA, NJTransit, PATCO and DART First State, as well as Amtrak (multi-trip tickets), VPSI and other third-party vanpool companies.
