1. Decline in federal lands in Burlington County due to reduction in parcels labeled federal in Bass River Township. Many lands owned by private or non-profit entities were misidentified as Federal in '07.
2. Decline in county lands in Burlington County due to Camp Ockanickon being designated as non-profit in '11, whereas it was designated as county in '07. Camp Ockanickon is owned by the YMCA.
3. The significant percentage increase in non-profit open space in Burlington County is due to a number of large-scale open space purchases by the New Jersey Conservation Foundation, Rancocas Conservancy, Nature Conservancy, and New Jersey Audubon. In addition, many areas identified as publically owned in 2007 were categorized as non-profit owned in 2011.
4. Decline in state lands in Camden County due to lands in Winslow owned by the New Jersey Natural Lands Trust being reclassified as non-profit.
5. The significant percentage increase in non-profit open space in Gloucester County is due to a number of open space purchases by New Jersey Audubon Society, New Jersey Conservation Foundation, New Jersey Natural Lands Trust, and small, local land trusts. There were also a number of areas identified as publically owned in 2007 that were categorized as non-profit owned in 2011.
6. Decline in state lands in Bucks County due to many of those lands in Warwick Township eased by the Natural Lands Trust now classified as non-profit.
7. The dramatic increase in municipal open space in Bucks County between 2007 and 2011 is due to the approval of an \$87 million Open Space Bond Referendum in November 2007.
8. Decline in county lands in Chester County due to lands in Newlin Township owned by the Natural Lands Trust now classified as Non-Profit.
9. Decrease in federal lands in Delaware County due to boundary line change along the Darby Creek.
10. Decline in county lands in Delaware County due to a boundary line change; lands in Cobbs Creek Park that were identified as in Delaware County in 2007 are identified in Philadelphia in 2011.
11. Decrease in federal lands in Philadelphia due to boundary line change along the Darby Creek.
12. With the 2010 merger of the Philadelphia Department of Recreation (formerly designated as municipal lands) and the Fairmount Parks Commission (formerly designated as county lands), all City-owned open space is now designated as county lands.
