- Difficult to use.



 - Structure: January 2000;
 - Design: April 2000.

- Orient users w/region map on homepage;
- “What’s New” contained in fixed area of scrolling announcements;
- Javascript mouseovers implemented to show contents of each section;
- Basic, homegrown sitesearch implemented using MS Access database;
- Design allowed for multiple programs to be featured on homepage.

The Transportation Planning Division of DVRPC is responsible for coordinating the transportation planning process conducted in the nine county region, collecting and providing data for regional studies, conducting research, and developing the long range transportation plan and the short term transportation improvement program.

Work undertaken by the Division is directed by the [Board](#) and its [committees](#) through the annual Work Program. Most of the work of the Transportation Division is reviewed by the [Regional Transportation Committee](#), at its monthly meetings.

Capital Programming

Here you will find everything you need to know about the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), special funding programs like Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) and Transportation Enhancements (TE), the region's most significant projects, and how DVRPC assists member agencies implement local projects.

Multi-Modal Planning

Multi-modal planning uses a comprehensive approach to improving the regions transportation system by considering many different modes of transportation in the planning process. This is the place to find out about DVRPCs work in Aviation Planning, Bicycle/Pedestrian Planning, Freight Planning, planning for Public Transit, and Safety Planning. Information on DVRPCs Traffic Studies and Corridor Studies can also be found here. Traffic counts for the regions highway system, conducted through DVRPCs Traffic Counting Program, are also available.

In accordance with [Executive Order 13166](#), DVRPC is employing a comprehensive strategy to provide translated information to the region's non-English speaking residents. DVRPC utilized the Year 2000 US Census information to determine the languages to be used on our site. Due to the high cost of professional translations, these resources will be rolled out in a phased manner.

For the initial phase, the following documents have been professionally translated into Spanish, Chinese and Russian:


Constants / Preliminary Findings

- All work will be done in-house;

- Languages (asp.net, vb.net, C#, javascript, XHTML 1.0);
- MS Access databases need to be migrated to Oracle;
- Too small to implement Content Management System;

Known Issues

- Great ranking in Google means most visitors bypass our homepage, missing important announcements;
- Planning programs are organized by old division lines (Transportation/Regional) – not intuitive to public;
- Some programs are buried 3 or more levels deep;
- Printing w/default 1” margins;
- Archived announcements are hard to find;
- “sticky” dropdown menus;
- Documents can be very large and difficult to download on dial-up connections.
