This will be done using a flex lane system that can alleviate persistent recurrent congestion along the corridor, reduce crashes, more specifically those related to rear-end collisions. better manage unbalanced traffic volumes, and better incentivize transit, bicycle and pedestrian trips throughout the corridor.
