

Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission Summary of 2040 Population Forecast Method

a. 2040 County Level Population Forecasts

Three alternative 2040 population forecasts were calculated for each county based on three separate methods, the results of which define a reasonable range of values within which each county's 2040 population total is expected to fall. This process mimics the process employed in 2007 to develop the Commission's adopted 2035 population forecasts, which used the three alternatives for initial guidance but adjusted the results based on significant input from the region's county planning staffs. The three alternative methods are as follow:

- An initial set of draft county-level 2040 forecasts was obtained by running the traditional age-cohort survival model used in the previous forecast round but updated to incorporate 2000, 2005, and 2010 population data in five-year age/sex cohorts. The 2000 and 2010 data are from the 2000 and 2010 U.S. Census of Population and Housing; the 2005 population by age/sex cohort was calculated by applying the percentages of the population in each age cohort from the 2005 American Community Survey (1-year estimates) to DVRPC's adopted 2005 population estimates. The model incorporates birth rates, death rates, survival rates, and migration as follows:
 - **Birth rate:** the model uses the number of live births per 1,000 women by 5-year age cohort in New Jersey in 2000, assuming that New Jersey statewide data is a better proxy for the Greater Philadelphia region's fertility than statewide data from Pennsylvania (which has many non-metropolitan counties).
 - **Survival rate:** as with birth rates, the model incorporates survival rates from the State of New Jersey. The survival rate is adjusted in the future based on assumed changes in mortality related to medical advances and lifestyle changes, using information provided through the National Vital Statistics System of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Between 2006 and 2007, for example, life expectancy increased by 0.2 percent nationwide because of decreases in mortality related to heart disease, cancer, influenza, pneumonia, stroke, and diabetes.
 - **Migration:** The model assumes that migration (the change in the population that cannot be explained through births and deaths) in future years will mimic the average 5-year migration rate experienced by each five-year age/sex cohort in each county between 2000 and 2010.

This age-cohort model replicates the model used in 2007 to develop an initial set of 2035 forecasts but incorporates more recent decennial Census and American Community Survey data to more accurately portray recent demographic trends. These trends include higher in-migration of seniors to certain areas of the region (such as Bucks County), declining overall fertility rates but higher fertility rates among older women (over age 35), and in-migration in Philadelphia and some of the region's older suburbs. Using the more current 2000 and 2010 Census data (rather than the 1990 and 2000 census data used in 2007) enables the model to produce forecasts through the year 2045, although the upcoming 2040 long range plan update requires the Commission to consider only the 2040 forecasts.

- A second set of county-level forecasts was developed utilizing the region-wide 2040 population forecast from the cohort component model described above but redistributing the total 2040 regional population to each of the nine counties based on the county

percentages from the adopted 2035 forecasts. This alternative acknowledges that the longer term development trends agreed upon during the process of developing the 2035 forecasts may be more important in some counties than the age cohort births/deaths and shorter term migration trends from 2000 to 2010 reflected in alternative one, and continues those longer term growth trends by reassigning the regional population among the nine counties, essentially adjusting migration rates to make up for birth-death effects.

- A third alternative set of county-level forecasts was developed by applying the growth rates between each 5-year time period from the Commission's adopted 2035 forecasts to the previous five-year total but using 2010 Census data as the base. The expected growth rate between 2035 and 2040 was based on the average change in the forecasted growth rate for each five-year increment between 2010 and 2035.

This alternative ignores the results of the most recent age-cohort model and simply extends the growth rates agreed upon during the process of developing the 2035 forecasts to 2040, as applied to the new 2010 base. This method assumes future population growth will follow previously adopted trends but adjusts for the differences in growth that occurred between 2000 and 2010, which was lower than the forecasted growth in all counties except Philadelphia and Delaware.

Based on the above steps, three alternative sets of 2040 forecasts were developed for each of the nine counties, resulting in an expected minimum and maximum 2040 population forecast for each county.

b. 2040 Municipal Level Population Forecasts

Each set of alternative county-level forecasts were disaggregated to the municipal level using the following method:

- The difference between the municipal-level 2010 Census population and the 2010 population forecast (adopted in June 2007) was calculated for each municipality.
- These differences were added or subtracted as appropriate from the adopted municipal-level 2035 forecasts. These adjusted 2035 forecasts were then used as a base for the development of 2040 municipal forecasts.
- The adjusted 2035 population forecasts were summed and the sum was compared to each of the three alternative county-level 2040 forecasts. For each set of alternatives, the percent of the population forecast to live in each municipality in 2035 (based on the adjusted 2035 forecasts) was applied to each of the 2040 county-level alternatives to create preliminary 2040 municipal forecasts, with the sum of all municipalities within each county matching the county-level 2040 forecast for each of the three alternatives.

The method assumes that the proportion of the county's population living in each municipality in 2035 will remain the same in 2040 and, when applied to the three alternative county-level forecasts, produced three alternative sets of municipal-level 2040 forecasts.

c. County Planning Staff Review of 2040 Forecasts

County planning staffs were asked to review the three alternative 2040 forecasts at the county and municipal level. In addition to each county's individual age-cohort component model, an Excel spreadsheet distributed to each county included:

- county and municipal level 2000 and 2010 Census data;
- DVRPC's adopted 2010 forecasts and the differences between these forecasts and 2010 Census population data;
- DVRPC's adopted 2035 forecasts;
- DVRPC's 2035 forecasts adjusted based on the 2010 Census;
- three sets of municipal-level 2040 forecast alternatives; and
- minimum and maximum county-level 2040 forecasts, based on the three methods.

Based on the data provided and local planning knowledge, the county planners recommended a final set of 2040 county and municipal forecasts which were reviewed and accepted by DVRPC.

d. Mid-Year Interim Population Forecasts

Once agreement was reached on the county and municipal-level 2040 population forecasts, forecasts for 2015, 2020, 2025, 2030, and 2035 were developed by DVRPC by applying a formula based on a theory of population growth and decline. These mid-cycle forecasts are needed for many DVRPC projects, such as conformity determination and transportation facilities programming.

To develop 2015, 2020, 2025, 2030, and 2035 interim year population forecasts, DVRPC applied a logit formula based on theoretical population growth and decline. A curve reflecting the rates of growth or decline between 2010 and 2040 (rather than a straight line) is used in this calculation, as illustrated below. While this method is similar to that used in previous years to determine the interim year forecasts, the factors used in the current round assume slower growth initially because of the ongoing economic recession. The model assumes that growth will pick up between 2020 and 2030 followed by slowing at the end. This results in an "S" or sigmoidal shaped curve.

e. County Planning Staff Review of Mid-Year Forecasts

While the pattern described above may be accurate on a regional or even county basis, the rate of growth may obviously differ in individual municipalities, especially those where pending development approvals or ongoing development activity are an indication that some expected growth will occur in the earlier years. County planners therefore reviewed the proposed interim forecasts and made adjustments as appropriate based on local planning knowledge. The spreadsheets titled "DVRPC 2040 County and Municipal-Level Population Forecasts in Five-Year Increments" reflect county planner feedback.

Logit formula for dividing population growth between interim years

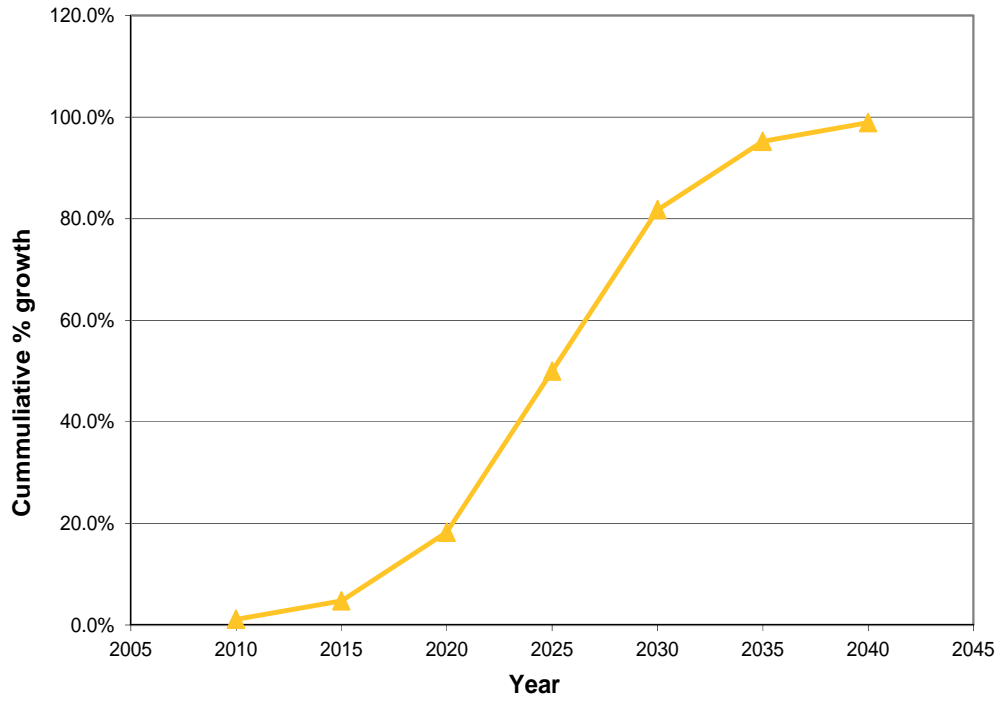
