

- Dedicated to farmland protection, environmental stewardship and agricultural viability







### **Most Food is Grown in Metro Areas**







# Now We're "Growing Local"

- Addressing barriers and leveraging opportunities to support local farms, farmers and farmland
- Focus on local and regional food systems in a smart growth context

Healthy Farms Healthy Food Healthy Communities





- Land not enough farmland is available and affordable to farmers
- Labor Too few farmers "growing local" to meet increased demand
- Logistics local/regional food system infrastructure has been dismantled
- Legislation 20<sup>th</sup> Century policies at local, state and federal levels don't meet 21<sup>st</sup> century needs and conditions

  - State creating policy suite and scorecard
  - Local planning for ag and improving ordinances
