## In Washington, DC?






# The federal government spends \$1.8 to \$2.8 billion a year for land conservation

- Donated easements = \$1-2 billion a year
- Farm Bill easements = \$400 million a year
- Interior Appropriations (LWCF, Forest Legacy, Sec. 6, NAWCA, State Wildlife Grants)
  - = \$400 million a year



Land People







- Land is getting more valuable

- Today, fewer than 2% of Americans live on a farm
- Today, 80.7 % of Americans live in "urban areas"
