This guide is intended to assist local and county governments, community groups, and non-profit organizations in the Delaware Valley Region in identifying federal, state, regional, county, and private sources of funding for locally initiated planning and development projects. The programs are listed in alphabetical order and cover topical areas of disaster and pollution mitigation, energy conservation, historic preservation, housing, infrastructure, infill and brownfields, open space and recreation, smart growth and community revitalization, transportation, and additional private resources.

Within this guide are a wide variety of sources that include grants, loans, tax credits, loan guarantees, municipal assistance, and reimbursement programs. To help locate a program of interest, the programs are listed alphabetically and cross-referenced by funding agency. Each program has information such as the organization administering the program, the terms, deadline, eligibility, and contact information.

In addition to acting as a resource for the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission's (DVRPC's) member governments, this guide also may be used as a resource for possible grant programs to be used as a match to DVRPC's Transportation and Community Development Initiative (TCDI) Grant Program. Purpose: To support environmental health services undertaken by local health agencies on behalf of the Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to the County Environmental Health Act

Terms: 50 percent match, except for pilot programs

Fire Management Assistance Grant Program

Eligibility: State and local governments

Purpose: To mitigate, manage, and control fires on publicly or privately owned forests or grasslands, which threaten such destruction as would constitute a major disaster

Terms: 75 percent federal cost share with states paying the remaining 25 percent

Eligibility: State and local governments

Growing Greener II

Eligibility: Pennsylvania local governments and non-profits

Purpose: Provides redevelopment grants to municipalities and non-profits to help a community's downtown redevelopment effort, focusing on the improvement of downtown sites and buildings

Terms: No minimum or maximum; typical grants average between \$250,000 and \$500,000

Hazard Mitigation Grant Program

Eligibility: State and local governments and certain non-profits located within a presidentially declared disaster area

Purpose: Provides grants to states and local governments to implement long-term hazard mitigation measures after a major disaster declaration

Terms: Grants may fund up to 75 percent of project costs; a 25 percent local match is required.

Deadline: As soon as possible after disaster

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Grant

Eligibility: Registered sponsors of hazardous waste collection programs

Eligibility: States and tribal organizations (must provide sub-grants to local municipalities)

Energy Conservation

Alternative and Clean Energy Program

Eligibility: Pennsylvania local governments, businesses, and schools

Purpose: To fund alternative and clean energy projects in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Terms: Loans shall not exceed \$5 million or 50 percent of total project cost; grants shall not exceed \$2 million or 50 percent of total project costs; matching investment required

Alternative Fuels Incentive Grant

Eligibility: Pennsylvania local governments, school districts, non-profits, and corporations

Terms: Single projects cannot receive more than 10 percent of funds available in any one funding year
