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Regional Data Bulletin

Population in DVRPC's 28-County Extended Data Services Area, 2000–2012





The Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC) is an interstate, inter-county, and intercity agency serving the Philadelphia-Camden-Trenton metropolitan area. As the region's metropolitan planning organization, DVRPC provides technical assistance and services to its member state and local governments. *Delaware Valley Data* is our periodic series of free data bulletins, analytical data reports, data reference guides, and data snapshots.

This regional data bulletin provides county and sub-county level population data for DVRPC's 28-county extended data services area. DVRPC's extended data services area (illustrated in Figure 1) includes Kent and New Castle counties in Delaware; Cecil and Harford counties in Maryland; Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Ocean, Salem, Somerset, and Warren counties in New Jersey; and Berks, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Lancaster, Lehigh, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia, and York counties in Pennsylvania.

Background


This regional data bulletin contains sub-county population estimates as of July 1, 2012, for the 28 counties located within DVRPC's extended data services area, as released by the U.S Census Bureau in May 2013. The Census Bureau's Population Estimates Program (PEP) produces July 1st estimates for the years following the last published decennial census and in most cases simultaneously revises annual estimates released in previous years. Existing data series such as births, deaths, federal tax returns, Medicare enrollment, and immigration are used to update the base counts from the decennial census. PEP estimates are used in federal funding allocations, in setting the levels of national surveys, and in monitoring recent demographic changes.

Area Definitions

In addition to providing data for the nine-county DVRPC region and its extended data services area, this data bulletin aggregates data as per the definitions of statistical areas issued by the federal Office of Management and Budget (OMB) in February 2013. The OMB defines Metropolitan, Micropolitan, and Combined Statistical Areas; New England City and Town Areas; and Metropolitan Divisions, for use in federal statistical analyses. These areas are revised every 10 years based on commuting ties between counties, and updated periodically to reflect changes in the population, based on the Census Bureau's PEP. Comparisons of this data with regional information issued earlier than 2013 should be made with caution but can be accomplished by aggregating individual county data.

- The Philadelphia-Camden-Wilmington Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) includes the Philadelphia, Pennsylvania Metropolitan Division; the Montgomery County-Bucks County-Chester County, Pennsylvania Metropolitan Division; the Camden, New Jersey Metropolitan Division; and the Wilmington, Delaware-Maryland-New Jersey Metropolitan Division.
 - The Philadelphia, Pennsylvania Metropolitan Division includes Delaware and Philadelphia counties in Pennsylvania.
 - The Montgomery County-Bucks County-Chester County, Pennsylvania Metropolitan Division includes Bucks, Chester, and Montgomery counties in Pennsylvania.


- The Camden, New Jersey Metropolitan Division includes Burlington, Camden, and Gloucester counties in New Jersey.

Highlights

Table 1 illustrates population change by county, and Table 2 provides data for the extended data services area, MSAs and metropolitan divisions. Table 3 summarizes information for the DVRPC region, and Tables 4 and 5 identify the 20 fastest-growing municipalities between 2010 and 2012 in the DVRPC region by absolute change and percent change, respectively. Appendix A provides population data and estimates for minor civil divisions (MCDs) in New Jersey and Pennsylvania (where MCDs serve as general-purpose local governments) and for incorporated places in Delaware and Maryland. Figures 2 and 3 illustrate the absolute and percentage change in population between 2000 and 2012 for the 28-county extended data services area, by MCD (in New Jersey and Pennsylvania) and incorporated place (in Delaware and Maryland).

- Based on absolute change, counties in DVRPC's extended data services area that realized the greatest population growth between 2000 and 2012 were Chester County, Pennsylvania (which gained 73,074 residents) and Middlesex County, New Jersey (which gained 72,879).
- In terms of percentage change, the fastest-growing counties in DVRPC's 28-county extended data services area between 2000 and 2012 were Kent County (Delaware) and Cecil County (Maryland), with population increases of 32 and 18 percent, respectively. Other fast-growing counties included Chester County (Pennsylvania), with a 17 percent increase; York County (Pennsylvania), with a 15 percent increase; and Harford County (Maryland), Gloucester and Ocean counties (New Jersey), and Lehigh County (Pennsylvania), which each realized population increases of 14 percent.
- Among all municipalities and incorporated areas in DVRPC's 28-county extended data services area, Lakewood Township (Ocean County, New Jersey) experienced the greatest absolute increase in population between 2000 and 2012, adding 32,388 residents. Other fast-growing communities included Philadelphia (both a city and a county), which gained 30,057 residents; Middletown Town (New Castle County, Delaware), which gained 13,322 new residents; Egg Harbor Township (Atlantic County, New Jersey), which gained 12,902 residents; and Jackson Township (Ocean County, New Jersey) and Monroe Township (Middlesex County, New Jersey), which gained 12,800 and 12,796 residents, respectively.
- By percentage, Cheswold Town (Kent County, Delaware) was the fastest-growing community in the 28-county region between 2000 and 2012, experiencing a 354 percent increase. Cheswold was followed by Woolwich Township (Gloucester County, New Jersey) with a 261 percent increase, Middletown Town (New Castle County, Delaware) with a 216 percent increase, Clayton Town (Kent County, Delaware) with a 136 percent increase, and Skippack Township (Montgomery County, Pennsylvania) with a 113 percent increase. In Ivyland Borough (Bucks County, Pennsylvania), an increase of 549 people translated into a 112 percent increase; and in New Morgan Borough (Berks County, Pennsylvania), 36 new residents resulted in a 103 percent increase.

by Municipality or Incorporated Place*: 2000–2012



- The population of the Philadelphia MSA increased by approximately six percent between 2000 and 2012, gaining 331,653 residents.
- The population of the nine-county DVRPC region increased by 286,150 (five percent) between 2000 and 2012, with the greatest percentage increases realized in Chester County, Pennsylvania, and Gloucester County, New Jersey.
- Each of the DVRPC region's nine counties saw increases in their populations over the 12-year time period, ranging from 4,607 (Camden County, New Jersey) to 73,074 (Chester County, Pennsylvania).
- After experiencing significant population declines during each of the previous three decades (with a total loss of over 432,000 residents between 1970 and 2000), Philadelphia's population grew by 30,057 between 2000 and 2012 (an increase of two percent).
- In absolute numbers, the increase of 7,905 residents in Woolwich Township (Gloucester County, New Jersey) between 2000 and 2012 was second in the nine-county region only to the City of Philadelphia and was followed by Monroe Township, also in Gloucester County (which gained 7,630 residents) and Concord Township in Delaware County, Pennsylvania (which gained 7,428).
- Based on percentage change, the fastest-growing municipality in the DVRPC region between 2000 and 2012 (and the second fastest-growing community in the 28-county data services area) was Woolwich Township (Gloucester County, New Jersey), which realized a population increase of 261 percent. Woolwich's growth was followed by Skippack Township (Montgomery County, Pennsylvania), where the population grew by 113 percent, and Ivyland Borough (Bucks County, Pennsylvania), with a 112 percent increase.
- Between April 2010 (the time of the 2010 census) and July 2012, communities in the 28-county extended data services area that realized the greatest absolute increases in population included the City of Philadelphia (which gained an estimated 21,601 additional residents over the two-year period); Monroe Township (Middlesex County, New Jersey), which gained 1,663 residents; Piscataway Township (also in Middlesex County), which saw a population increase of 1,606; Upper Macungie Township (Lehigh County, Pennsylvania), which gained 1,486 residents; and Carteret Borough (also in Middlesex County) which gained 1,218 residents.
- In the nine-county DVRPC region, municipalities gaining the most residents between the time of the 2010 Census and July 2012 included Philadelphia; West Windsor Township (Mercer County, New Jersey), which gained 1,028 residents; Cinnaminson Township (Burlington County, New Jersey), which gained 840 residents; West Goshen Township (Chester County, Pennsylvania), which gained 826 residents; and New Hanover Township (Montgomery County, Pennsylvania), which gained 764 residents.
- Communities in the 28-county extended data services area with the highest percentage increases in population between 2010 and 2012 included Lebanon Borough (Hunterdon County, New Jersey), where the population increased by 47 percent; East Bangor Borough (Northampton County, Pennsylvania), with a 17 percent increase; Windsor Borough (York County, Pennsylvania), with a 12 percent increase; and Stewartsville Borough (also in York County), with an 11 percent increase.
- In the nine-county DVRPC region, municipalities realizing the highest percentage increases in population since 2010 included Avondale Borough (Chester County, Pennsylvania) and Swedesboro Borough (Gloucester County, New Jersey), both with ten percent increases; Delanco Township (Burlington County) and East Brandywine Township (Chester County, Pennsylvania), both with eight percent increases; and Woolwich Township (Gloucester County, New Jersey), where the population increased by seven percent.
