





# **DVRPC GRANTS \$1.5 MILLION FOR REVITALIZATION PROJECTS** 24 Municipalities In Pennsylvania And New Jersey Receive Funds

or the second year in a row, DVPRC awarded Transportation and Community Development Initiative (TCDI) grants at the Celebration of Regional Excellence. Twenty-four area municipalities will share \$1.5 million in grants to support local development efforts in communities that implement municipal, county, state and regional planning objectives. The TCDI program assists in reversing the trends of disinvestment and decline in many of the region's core cities and first generation suburbs by supporting local planning projects that will lead to more residential, employment or retail opportunities; by improving the overall character and quality of life within these communities to retain business and residents; by enhancing and using the existing transportation infrastructure capacity in these areas to reduce demands on the transportation network; and by reducing congestion and improving the transportation system's efficiency.



Representatives from each of the 24 municipalities were recognized at the Celebration for Regional Excellence in June.
