This project includes the widening of County Lines Road from 2 lane to 5 lanes with 5' shoulders. The project length is approximately 2 miles. The posted speed limit for the project area is 45 MPH and the design speed is 50 MPH. The project also includes intersection improvements at the Stumper Road/Kulper Road intersection and the addition of sidewalks. This project will also eliminate multiple substandard vertical curves along the road, which contribute to safety concerns at the intersection. The project may include the construction of two noise barriers and will include 61 partial right of way takes. There are no anticipated residential or commercial relocations as a result of this project.

Project CMP (Congestion Management Process) commitments include strategies such as improvements for bicyclists, pedestrians, and drivers on the existing road network (operations). See DVRPC's 2008 annual memoranda on supplemental strategies for details related to this project.
