

Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Awards

Project Performance Period: October 1, 2015—March 31, 2017

Delaware County

- **Delaware County Conservation District** – \$20,000 to employ a specialist to implement and track coastal non-point pollution management measures.
- **Marcus Hook Borough** – \$10,000 to perform an underwater inspection of the fishing pier and two icebreakers at Market Square Memorial Park.

Total: \$30,000

Philadelphia County

- **Academy of Natural Sciences** – \$17,859 to monitor freshwater tidal wetlands, evaluate wetland sustainability and develop conservation strategies in the Delaware Estuary.
- **Partnership for the Delaware Estuary, Inc.** – \$32,527 to conduct Pennsylvania Coast Day 2016 events, which educate the public about coastal recreation, historic sites, and public access.
- **Pennsylvania Horticultural Society** – \$28,547 to conduct a planning study for connecting the Port Richmond neighborhood to the Delaware River waterfront via Castor Avenue.
- **Schuylkill River Development Corporation** – \$2,240 to provide urban youth free aquatic recreational experiences on the Schuylkill River.
- **Schuylkill River Development Corporation** – \$49,000 to conduct a planning study for expanding the Schuylkill River Trail from Christian Street to the Grays Ferry Crescent trail and greenway.

Total: \$130,173

Bucks County

- **Bucks County Conservation District** – \$20,000 to employ a specialist to implement and track Coastal Non-Point Pollution management measures.
- **Heritage Conservancy** – \$10,000 to restore and steward Bristol Marsh Preserve and Mill Creek through educational programs and clean-up days.
- **Pennsylvania Environmental Council** – \$45,000 to undertake preliminary engineering for two segments of the East Coast Greenway in Bensalem Township.

Total: \$75,000

Coastal Zone Wide

- **Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission** – \$50,000 to implement the Coastal Management Program in the Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone that includes Delaware, Philadelphia, and Bucks counties.
- **Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful** – \$25,000 to plan, organize, oversee, and report on the 2016 International Coastal Cleanup in Pennsylvania's Delaware Estuary.

Total: \$75,000
