

Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone Federal Fiscal Year 2017 Awards

Project Performance Period: October 1, 2017—March 31, 2019

Delaware County

- **City of Chester** – \$40,000 to construct a segment of the Chester Creek Trail called the Levee Walk.
- **Marcus Hook Borough** – \$40,000 for the Delaware River fishing pier structural improvement project.

Total: \$80,000

Philadelphia County

- **Delaware River Basin Commission** – \$50,000 to conduct technical and economic evaluation of nutrient treatment technologies.
- **John Bartram Association** – \$40,000 for design of riverfront infrastructure, shoreline improvements, and pathways along the Schuylkill River in Bartram's Garden.
- **Partnership for the Delaware Estuary, Inc.** – \$28,000 to conduct Pennsylvania Coast Day 2018 events to educate the public about coastal recreation, historic sites, and public access.
- **Philadelphia Parks and Recreation** – \$26,500 to construct a vegetated bioswale along the Schuylkill River Trail.
- **Schuylkill River Development Corporation** – \$36,000 to complete the final design for a new segment of Schuylkill Banks, part of the Schuylkill River Trail, from Bartram's Garden to 61st Street.

Total: \$180,500

Coastal Zone Wide

- **Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission** – \$45,000 to implement the Coastal Management Program in the Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone that includes Delaware, Philadelphia, and Bucks counties.
- **Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission** – \$50,000 to conduct outreach to municipalities in the Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone focused on climate resiliency and related hazard mitigation.

Total: \$95,000
