The Route 33 highway section will consist of two 12-foot through lanes westbound, one 12-foot through lane eastbound, and 10-foot outside shoulders. Route 33 at the intersection of Route 130 will consist of one through lane eastbound, a shared through/right-turn lane, and left-turn lane, one through lane westbound and two left-turn lanes. The Route 130 highway section would remain as is with improvements to the northbound alignment. The intersection of Route 33 and Route 130 would have a single traffic signal, and Sharon Road will be redesigned as a right-in and right-out only intersection with no signal required.
